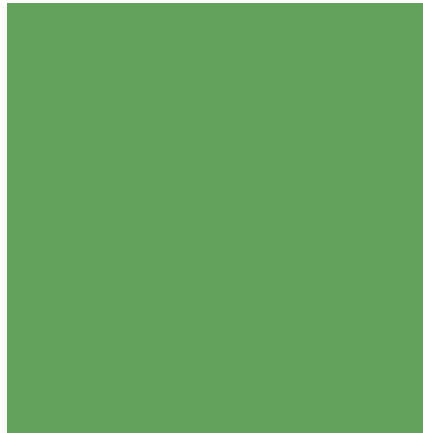
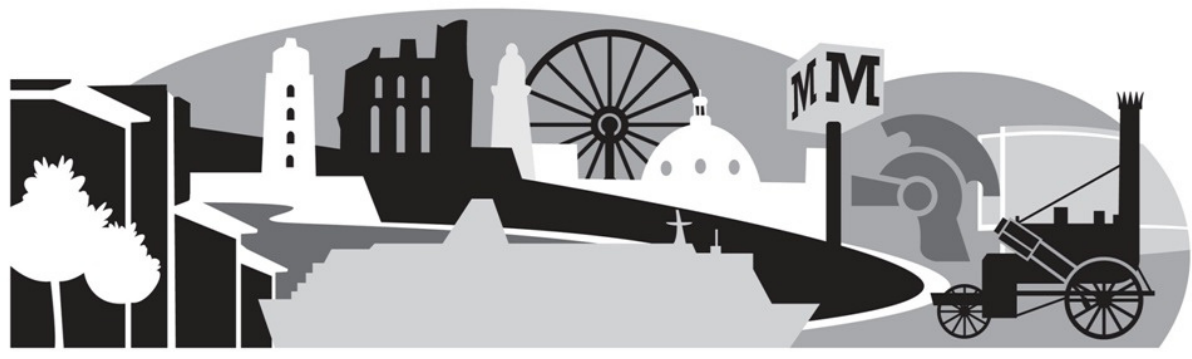

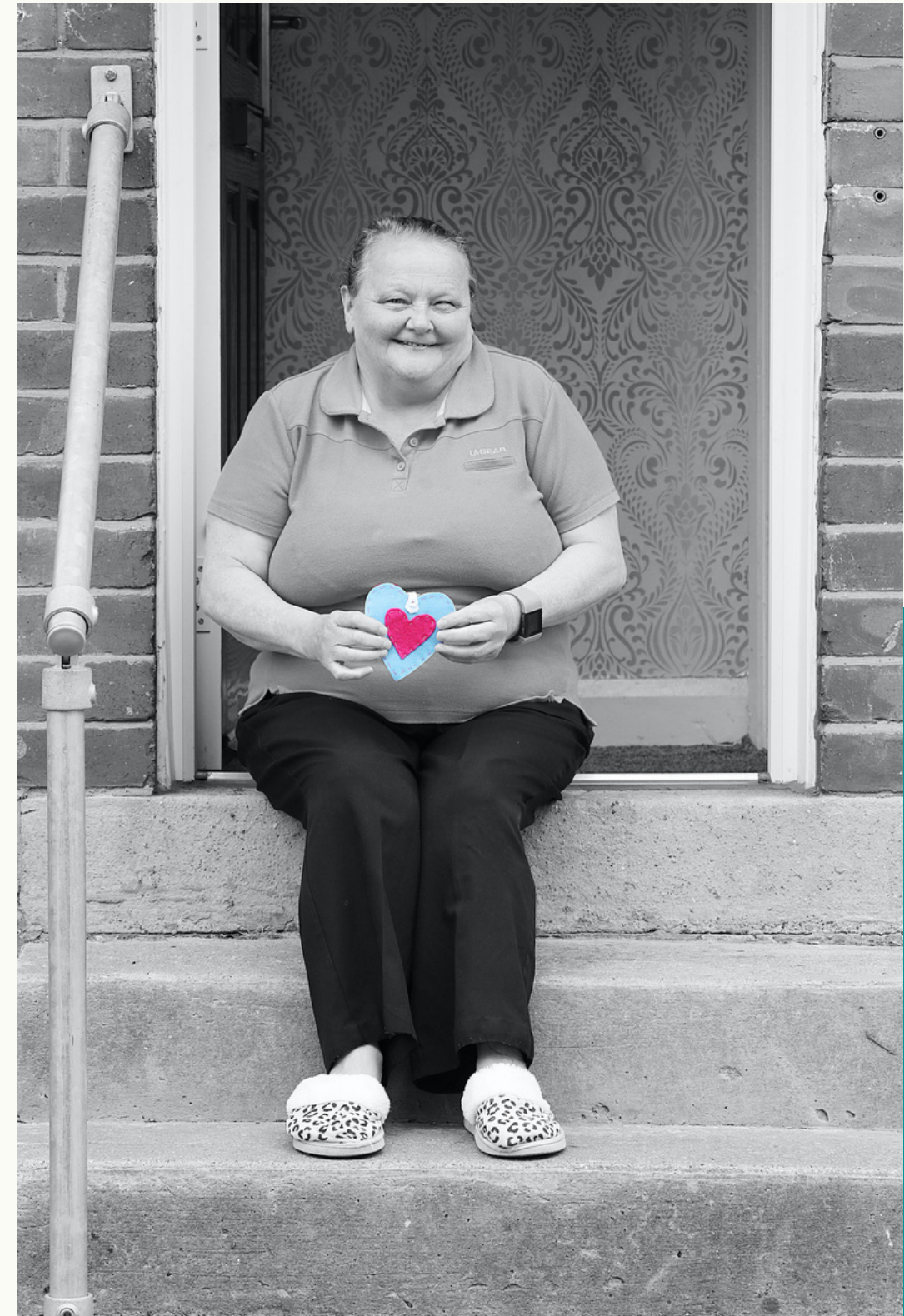




IMPACT OF COVID

THE COVID 19 PANDEMIC CONTINUES TO HAVE A DEVASTATING IMPACT ON OUR COMMUNITIES:

- Increase risk of falling into **poverty** due to loss of employment and education
- Negative impact on **mental health** due to breakdown in relationships, debt and isolation





LOCAL RESPONSE

AT TIMES THE RESPONSE MAY HAVE LACKED CO-ORDINATION, BUT IT WAS ALWAYS COMMITTED

- **North Tyneside Council** established Local Support System
- **VCS** refocussed their efforts
- **Businesses** offered their support
- **Neighbours** looked after one-another
