I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to request the following from your finance systems and Accounts Payable department:

Is this split out by sector / category or can you identify SME suppliers that have been paid late? If so, what are the volumes values?

We do not categorise the sectors in relation to SME

How many claims have you processed for late payment of invoices? How many claims were successful and how many were rejected (and for what reason)? (Volumes and values of claims)

In instances where a late payment charge applies, the relevant service area liaise with the supplier in question and any additional charges approved by the usual invoice matching process.

These are dealt with on a case by case basis and volumes of claims is not held.

Do you have a documented process for late payment claims? If so, is this published and can it be shared? In the absence of a process, where should late payment claims be submitted?
