## Request:

Please could you provide me with your latest municipal waste composition report, split by household and non-household, along with the date of the study. Could you also provide me with the report made previous to that.

## Response:

The local authority has to submit all its waste data to the government on a quarterly basis detailing all materials collected and where it was recycled and how it was disposed of. The public can access all this data from the WasteDataFlow website.

WasteDataFlow is a web-based system for waste data reporting by UK local authorities to government. The system went live on 30 April 2004, and was designed for local authorities to allow faster and more accurate data collection of waste statistics, to enhance their local data management for reporting and strategic planning purposes and to offer them streamlined access to performance benchmarking with other authorities
