 - 9 Children Centres were handed back to Schools/Nurseries to provide services for under 5's following a review of children's centre provision. The Authority withdrew from the direct childcare provision in a number of settings, following a phased review, which concluded that sufficient high-quality provision was available in alternative settings. 7 Nurseries were closed as a result. No buildings were sold.
