## Request:

As per the Freedom of Information Act, can you please provide an answer to the following:

- a. As a local authority, do you provide a School Uniform Grant? (it may be called a different name in your authority, but is generally known as this)
- b. what is the lowest Grant to have paid to a household for this academic year?
- c. what is the highest Grant you have paid to a household for this academic year?
- d. When does your Grant scheme run from and till each year? (I understand that some local authorities have schemes that run from June to September, for example)
- e. Within the time-frame above, where relevant, how much in £ have you paid out in total? (if your Grant scheme is year-round, please provide the amount you have issued for the academic year that started last month.
