**Request:**

I have attached documents which relate to a revision to the site of Tynemouth Outdoor Pool.

Could you give me more information on the reasons for which this revision has been made and the names of the 'others' associated with the Duke of Northumberland in this revision?

**Response:**

The reason for the change was to amend a restrictive covenant within the title to allow a business pod to be located in a position shown on the attached plan.

It is not unusual for the title of land to relate to a wider area which may include Tynemouth Outdoor Pool on this occasion, however, the consent given would not cover any other land other than that shown on the plan.

The others in the document refer to '...the honourable James William Eustace Percy and the honourable George Dominic Percy as the trustees of the tenth duke of Northumberland's 1972 referential settlement'
