**Request:**

Please could you supply the total figure allocated for the Rake Lane roundabout scheme from the Active Travel Fund?

Please also supply whether this money was spent entirely, and if not what happened with the excess.

**Response:**

The upgrades on A191 Rake Lane and New York Bypass, including the roundabout works, are part of the 'Strategic Corridors' scheme, funded from the Government's Active Travel Fund (tranche 2) and the total grant funding available for the scheme is £1.575m.

The full funding has been allocated to these works and those on the Middle Engine Lane corridor. Whilst the construction works are substantially complete, the project has not yet reached financial completion and hence detailed information on total expenditure is not available at present.
