Request:

Please provide me with the following information based on Council Tax increases:

1. The total number of Households by Band (A, B, C, D etc.), that had a percentage increase in council tax over 2.99% for fiscal year 2020-2021.
2. The total number of Households by Band (A, B, C, D etc.), that had a percentage increase in council tax over 5% for fiscal year 2021-2022.
3. The total number of Households by Band (A, B, C, D etc.), that had a percentage increase in council tax over 5% for fiscal year 2022 – 2023.
4. The total number of Households by Band (A, B, C, D etc.), that had a percentage increase in council tax over 5% for fiscal year 2023 – 2024.
5. Please also supply the total number of properties per area (town village, postcode etc.), that exceeded the percentage changes for each of the fiscal years above.
6. Please also confirm if the council is classed as an “adult social care authority”.
7. If the council is an “adult social care authority”, confirm if the council are implementing the deferred precept flexibility and by what percentage are the council applying to the above periods 2020-2024.

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Response:

1. As at annual billing for 2020-21, the number of properties per band in North Tyneside subject to an increase in council tax over 2.99% were as follows:
Band A: 50360
Band B: 15782
Band C: 19469
Band D: 8028
Band E: 4125
Band F: 1376
Band G: 363
Band H: 38
2. 0 (zero) properties were subject to a percentage increase over 5% in 2021-22.
3. 0 (zero) properties were subject to a percentage increase over 5% in 2022-23.
4. As at annual billing for 2023-24, the number of properties per band in North Tyneside subject to an increase in council tax over 5% were as follows:
Band A: 50507
Band B: 16010
Band C: 19855
Band D: 8359
Band E: 4391
Band F: 1529
Band G: 369
Band H: 36

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5. 0 (zero) properties exceeded the percentage changes (that were allowed) for each of the fiscal years.
6. North Tyneside Council is classed as an adult social care authority.
7. The Authority applied precept flexibility and charged an additional Adult Social Care precept on its council tax. Please see below the % increase applied for the following periods 2020 - 2024.
