The amount it costs each time residents wish to use council provided tips

North Tyneside Councils HWRC (Household Waste Recycling Centre) is free to use for residents

Your average bin collection rates (success as a percentage)

100%

How often on bins are collected

Bins are collected alternate weekly

The average size (in litres) of your bins

240 litre capacity

How much (in tonnes) your council recycled in the last full year you have information for 2019-20

Kerbside grey bins recycling 15,868.99 tonnes. Garden waste 11,082.62 tonnes. Transfer station and Household Waste Recycling Centre recycling 7,558.83 tonnes. Reuse at Household Waste Recycling Centre (bicycles, gas bottle etc) 26.46 tonnes.

What percentage of refuse collected by your local authority is recycled (i.e. does not go to landfill)

Refuse collection is not broken down individually but the total recycled of the overall municipal solid waste (MSW) received was 38.73% Only 1216.79 tonnes (1.28% of total MSW) went to landfill. The remainder of the waste 58,625.89 tonnes was sent for Energy for Waste (EfW)
