2. What training/qualifications do Community Protection Officers/Enforcement officers require in order to the job role.

Training in enforcement procedures and techniques applicable to the post. Ability to decide on the most appropriate non-legal and / or legal remedy to resolve an anti-social behaviour / environmental complaint. Ability to prepare written reports and witness statements and present in court.

3. What training do they receive before being able to issue fines/notices.

Officers are instructed in the use of Fixed Penalty Notice issuing and completion of the Pocket Notebook to accompany the ticket.

4. Are they trained in the Care Act and Equality Act to ensure they deal with people with disabilities appropriately?

Officers are not trained specifically in the Care Act but must complete e-learning on Equality and Diversity.

5. What identification do enforcement officers carry and do they have to produce it on request by a member of the public?

Officers should be wearing identification and should produce it on approaching a member of the Public. They will also when requested by a member of the Public produce their identification.
