**Request:**

How much the council has spent on fire risk assessments in each year from 2007/08 to 2017/18

Between April 2007 & June 2012 the Council spent Circa £35k/annum (equivalent to one full time officer undertaking FRAs within the Council's portfolio).  
Between July 2012 to date Capita spent approximately £35k per annum, equivalent to one full time surveyor to undertake FRAs on behalf of North Tyneside Council.

Who has carried out your fire risk assessments in each year from 2007/08 to 2017/18 - name of company/individual

Between April 2007 & June 2012 the Council undertook FRAs using its own directly employed staff, with responsibility split between 2 officers who spent approximately 50% of their working hours undertaking FRAs which equated to the £35k figure quoted above. Between July 2012 to date Capita undertook FRAs using its own employed staff and a subcontractor (Company Name Onaek).
