1) According to your most up to date information, which schools in the North Tyneside area provide halal meat dinners for children, and for how long?

a) Could you please name them?

b) Could you also state the percentage of muslim children in these schools? (best guess estimate in the case that accurate figures are not available please).

2) If schools serve halal meat is there also a non-halal meat option for non-muslim children at the same time?

The halal slaughter process is opposed by the Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals who stated: "A large cut made across the neck of a conscious animal would "result in very significant pain and distress" before the animal loses consciousness"., and "Slaughter without pre-stunning is unacceptable and that the Government should repeal the current exemption".
