Great Lime Road, Forest Hall was the most complained about street in 2016/17.

Road name of the road which has had the most money spent on it's repairs - Postcode - Value of repairs to that road in £'s.

Hadrian Road, Wallsend had the most money spent on repairs in 2016/17, North Tyneside Highways department spent £1137.00 on localised pothole and patch repairs.

Please note that in addition to localised repairs, Great Lime Road and Hadrian Road have been fully resurfaced. The costs are shown below:

Great Lime Road £104,199.55

Hadrian Road £146,000
