Dear Sirs,

I write to object to the above TPO which is on land in the ownership of my family.

I have put forward (via my tree surgeon) a proposal for removing selected trees on our land. The report from David Whelan (Tynemouth Tree Surgeons) was considered by the Council Reference - 17/01744/TPO but we believe the Council's response raises doubts and concerns over the assessment of certain trees. The trees to be removed have a range of problems which are not reflected in your own report. By example I have attached a photograph of a tree which we consider should be removed but your own report suggests otherwise. Therefore, whilst such disparities exist we would welcome a joint site meeting in the next week to establish an agreed position before the TPO is confirmed. If you would agree to this modest request then it would allow an informed and mutually respectful way forward.

Please confirm receipt of this Objection and in light of my concerns what action you now propose to take.
