I am in favour of the development which provides a good sports resource for the community.

Additional Comments from Applicant

I noticed that in the latest comment provided by the residents who have requested to speak they have stated in paragraph 7.0 that “the new floodlights alone will be almost double the height of those currently in place”. This prompted me to re-check the height of the existing floodlights.

I can confirm that three of the existing floodlights are 15m high and one is 17.5 high. I have checked this against previous planning applications for the site. The proposed new floodlights will all be 15m high.

However, in my addition planning statement (paragraph 5) I said, “there are more columns at a lower level”. This statement was made in good faith as I believed that all existing columns were 17.5m high. It was a genuine error and was not done in any way to mislead. I thought I should highlight this to you in case there are any questions on this matter at committee. The facts are that the new columns will be the same size as

existing except for one of the existing which is 2.5m higher.

Officer Comment

The existing floodlights are 15m in height and one is 17.5m. The proposed new floodlights will all be 15m in height.
