Summary of proposed change to Service

This proposal is in line with the plan to develop a 10 year plan for waste strategy to ensure North Tyneside remains a great place to live, work and visit. For ecological and financial reasons it is imperative that local authorities have long term plans for waste. This proposal aims to establish a 10 year plan to increase recycling and contain the growth of waste costs as well as developing a post 2022 solution for disposal of residual waste.

Following the implementation of alternate weekly collections, we have continued to analyse the impact of the revised workload on our collection arrangements.

As our residents and the collection teams settle into the new working arrangements, it will be possible to release further financial efficiencies from collection activities resulting from this service change.

The change will involve the reduction of one collection round, by redistributing the workload across other collection teams. This will result in a further vehicle and staffing saving of circa £100K.
