Summary of proposed change to Service

As part of the aim to ensure North Tyneside remains a great place to live, work and visit an efficiency strategy for Post – 2019 Construction Delivery has been made.

Throughout 2018/19 the Construction Project has been working to prepare for the return of services for the delivery of construction services to both the Housing Revenue Account and the General Fund. This project will continue into 2019/20 as over 400 staff are TUPE'd into the Authority and a re-modelled approach to delivery is implemented in order to reduce cost and grow the business in the future.
