1% point increase in feeling that the council keeps people informed

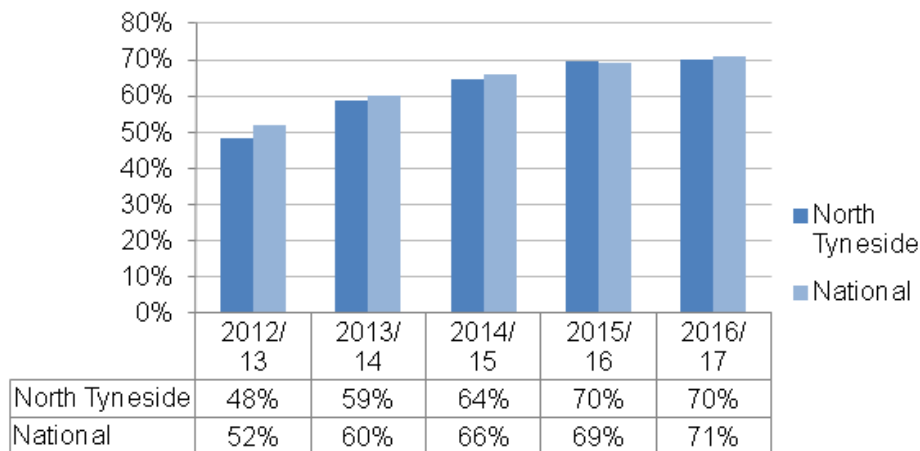


3% point increase in belief that the council acts on the concerns of local people



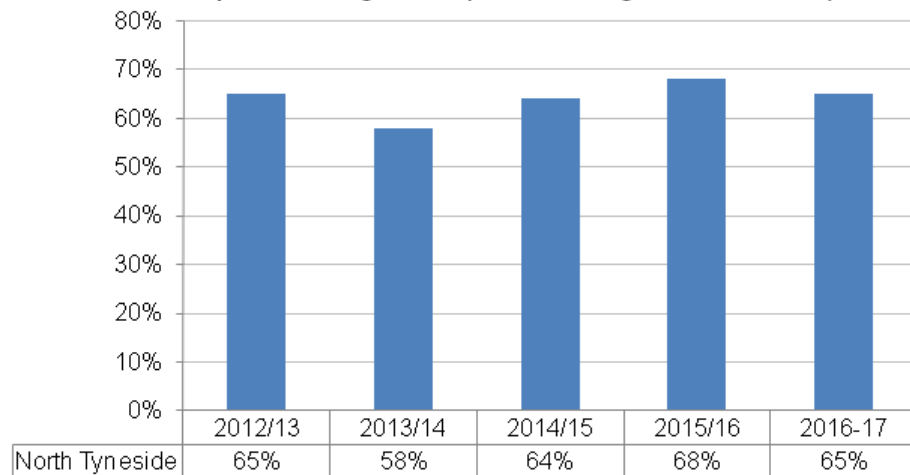

% pupils with a Good Level of Development at Foundation Stage

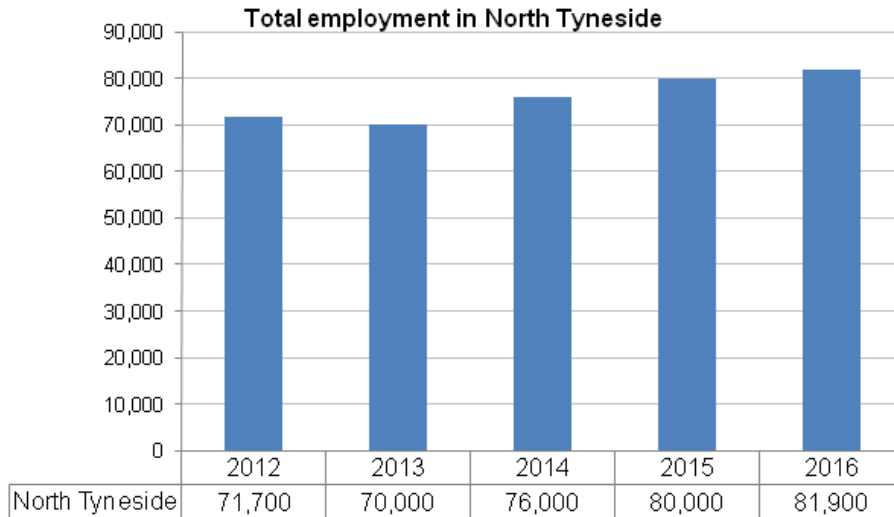


- Attainment improved at Foundation Stage and Key Stage 4 (GCSE) since 2013

- National changes make it difficult to compare at Key Stage 4

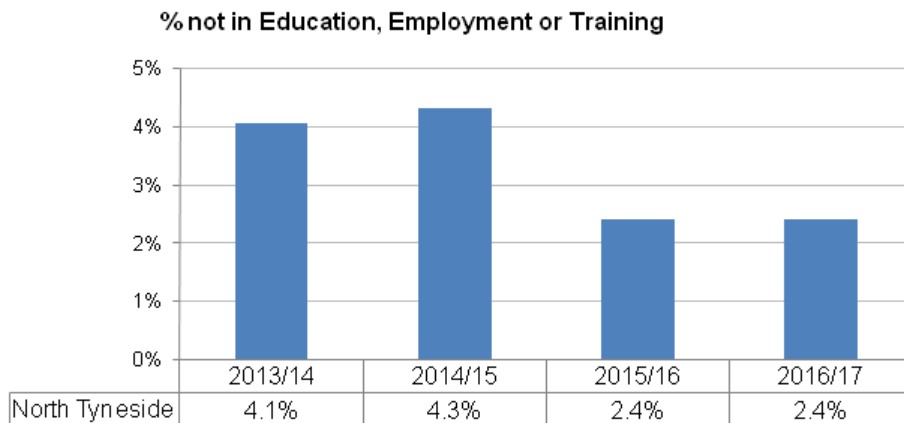
% Pupils achieving Basics (A* to C in English and Maths at) KS4



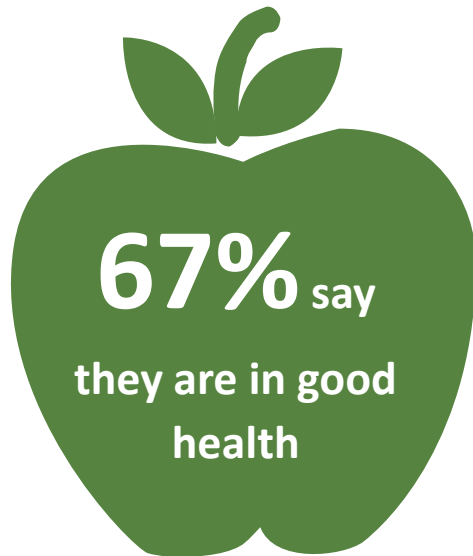

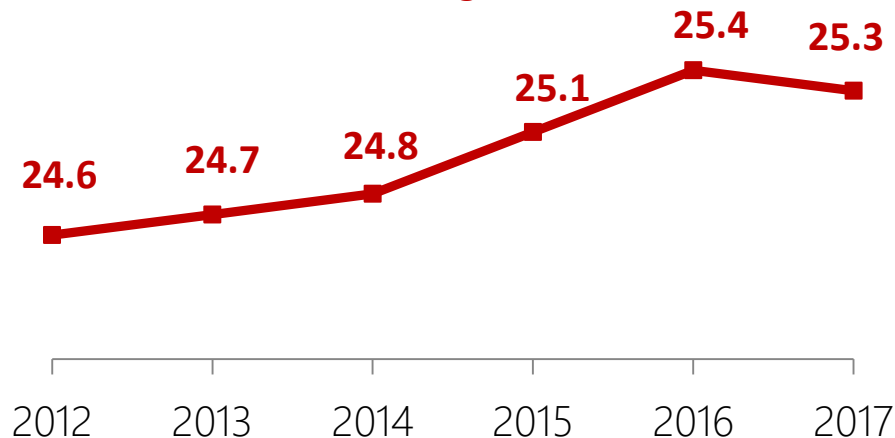
- More people overall are in employment

- Fewer young people are also Not in Education, Employment or Training



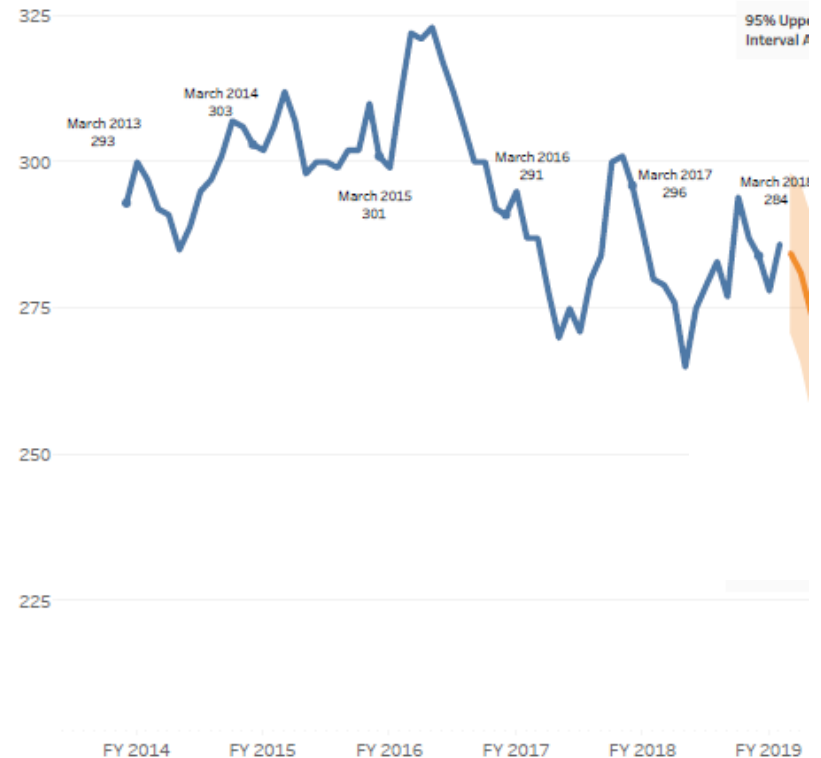

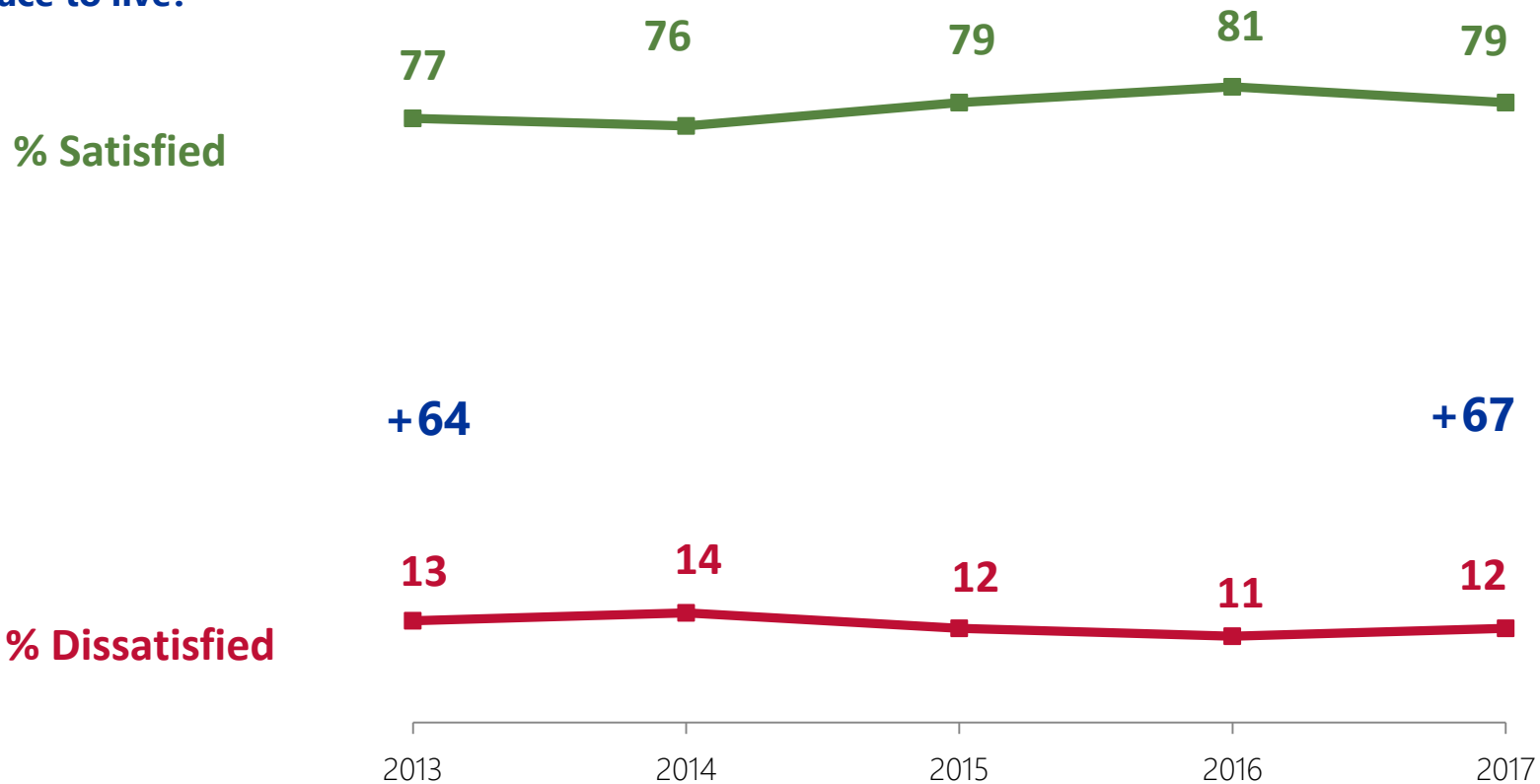
Our Places will

- Have an effective transport and physical infrastructure - including our roads, cycleways, pavements, street lighting, drainage and public transport

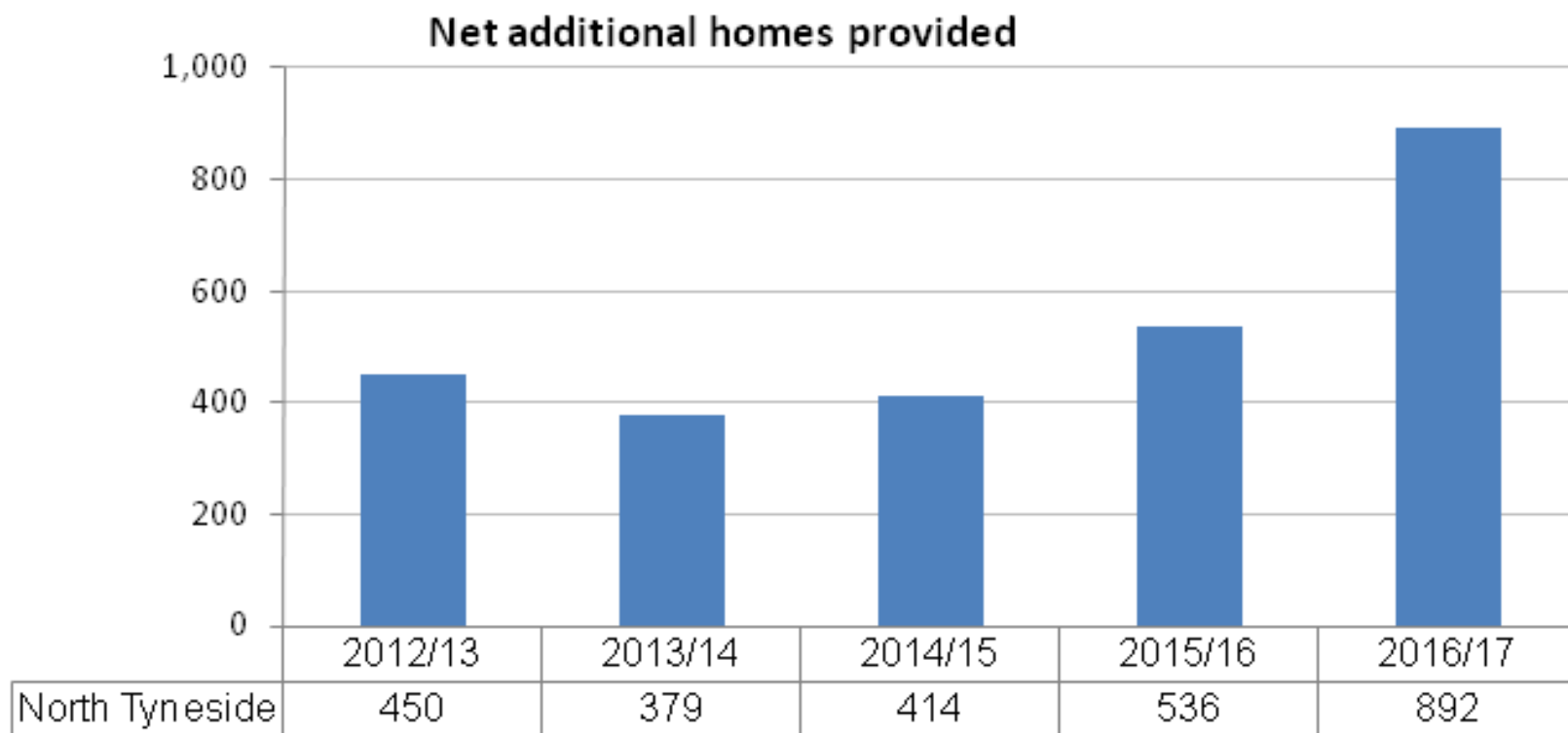

Response to the question "Overall, how satisfied or dissatisfied are you with your local area as a place to live?"

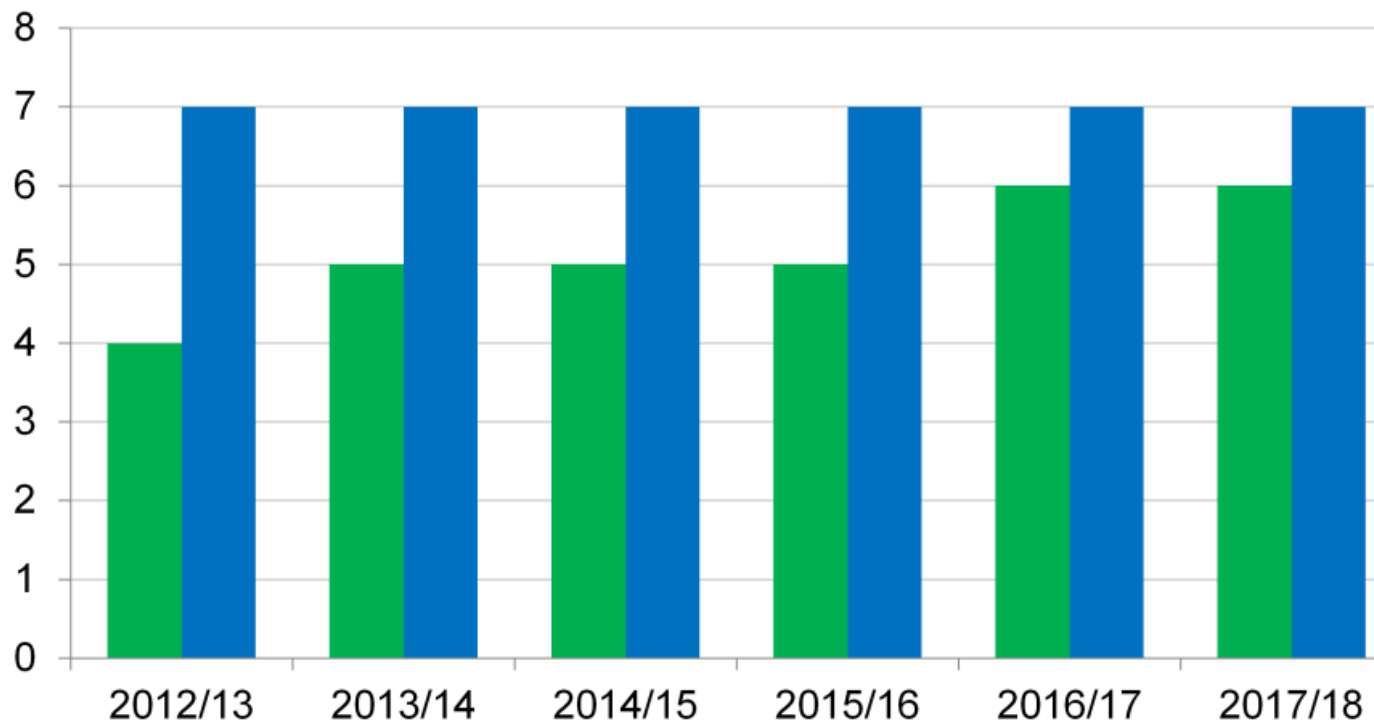

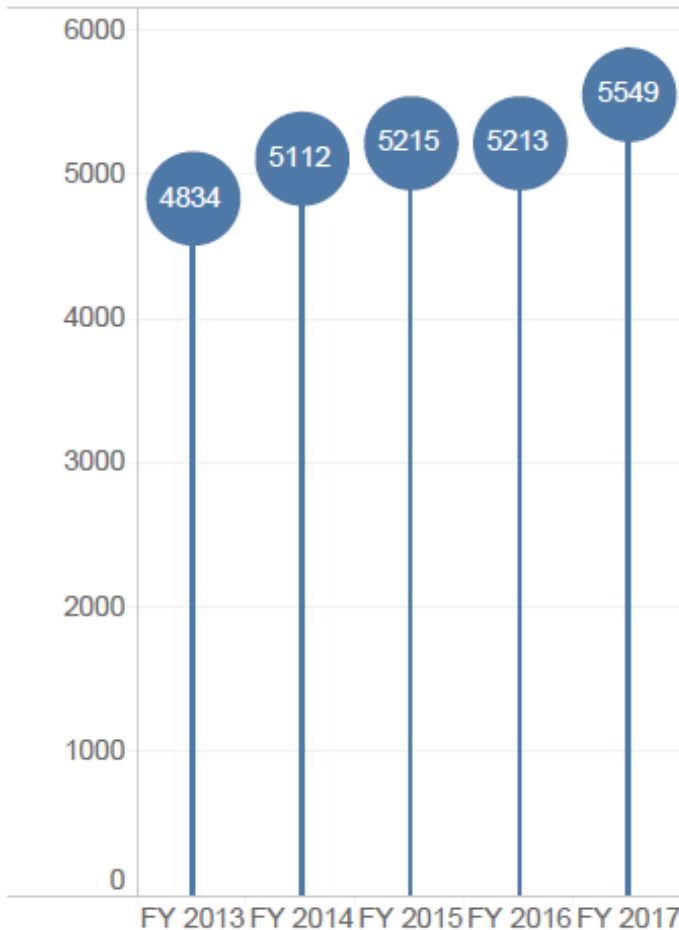
Our Economy will

- Have the right skills and conditions to support investment, and create and sustain new, good-quality jobs and apprenticeships for working-age people

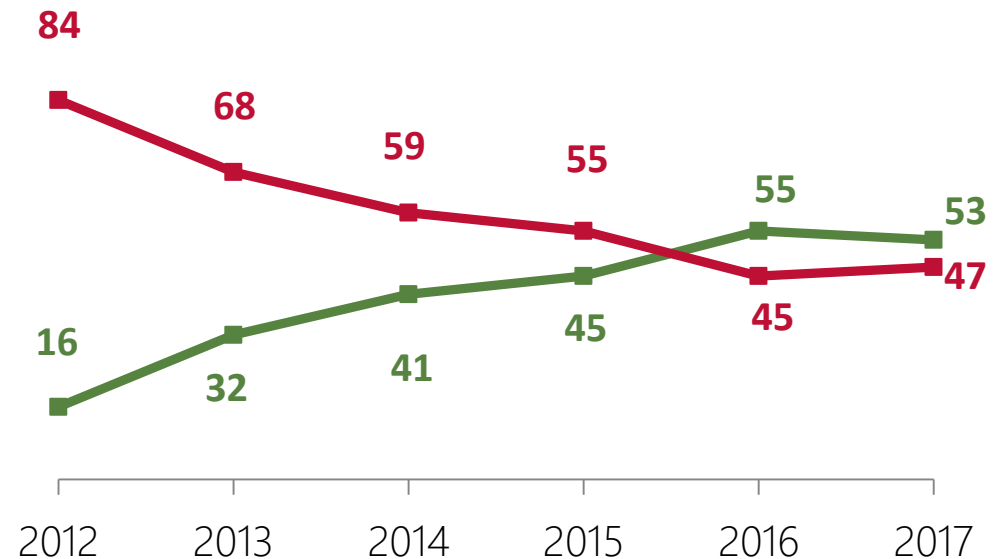

Business Rate Payers

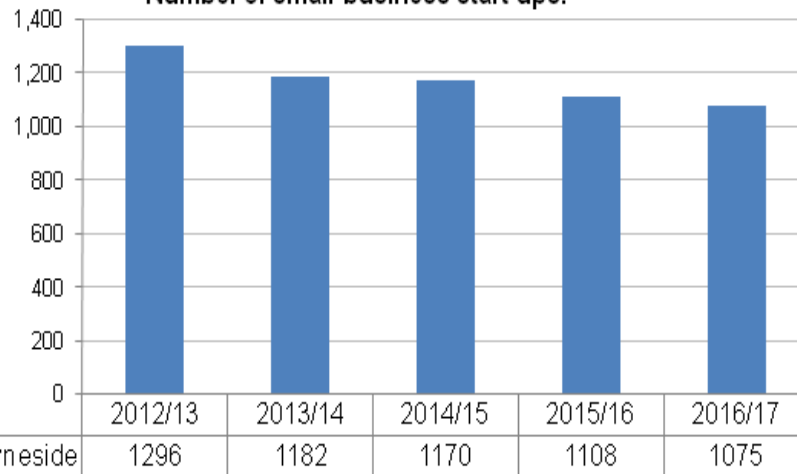


Local view on the state of the local economy

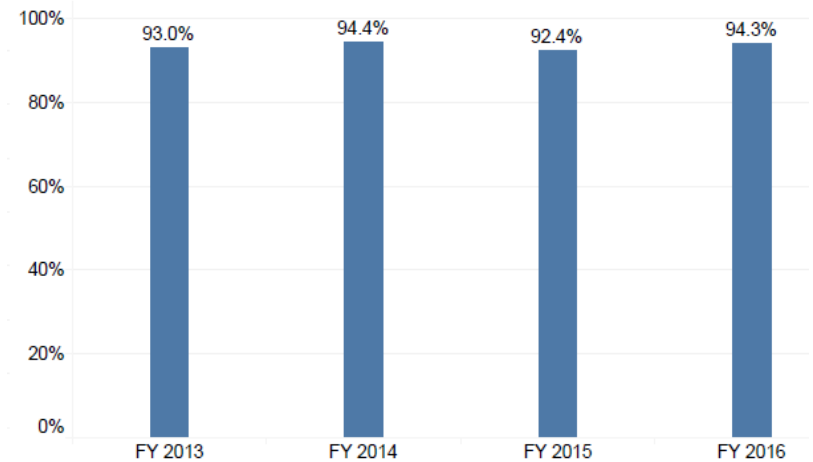
