

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTH TYNESIDE
(SCHOOL STREETS TRANCHE 3) (EXPERIMENTAL)
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023**

The Council of the Borough of North Tyneside in exercising its powers under Sections 1, 2, 9 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, hereby make the following Experimental Order:

Commencement and Citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 4th September 2023 for a period not exceeding 18 months and may be cited as the Council of the Borough of North Tyneside (School Streets Tranche 3) (Experimental) Traffic Regulation Order 2023.

Interpretation

2. In this Order the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them:-

“Disabled Persons Badge” means a valid badge issued by the Council or authorised provider in accordance with the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000, as amended.

“Hackney Carriage” means a vehicle licensed under Section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847.

“Private Hire Vehicle” means a vehicle licensed under Section 80 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976.

“The Council” means the Council of the Borough of North Tyneside or any person or organisation authorised to act on their behalf.

Prohibition of Driving – Motor Vehicles

3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of the Council or a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the roads or lengths of road or footway specified in Schedule 1 to this Order during the prescribed days and hours specified in the said Schedule.

Exemptions

4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to:
 - (a) Any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade and ambulance purposes;



- (b) Any vehicle being used by Healthcare Workers (including doctors on call, district nurses, personal carers, support workers and essential healthcare visitors).
- (c) Any operational vehicle being used in connection with:-
 - i. Building or demolition operations in or adjacent land or removal from adjacent land or buildings where the prior written consent of the Council has been received;
 - ii. The laying, erection, alteration or repair of sewer pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas, electricity or telecommunications apparatus in or on adjacent land;
 - iii. The maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the highway.
- (d) Any vehicle being used in the service of a Universal Service Provider to deliver or collect postal packets as defined in Section 125(1) of the Postal Services Act 2000 to premises situated on or adjacent to the roads or lengths of roads named;
- (e) Any vehicle being used in the service of the Council in pursuance of its statutory duties;
- (f) Any vehicle if it is in use as a School Bus and being contracted to carry persons to or from a school located on or adjacent to the roads or lengths of roads named;
- (g) A Hackney Carriage or Private Hire Vehicle operating to uplift or set down passengers at/from any premises located on or adjacent to the roads or lengths of roads named;
- (h) any vehicle displaying a Disabled Persons Badge, being driven by or carrying a disabled person to uplift or set down passengers at/from any premises located on or adjacent to the roads or lengths of roads named;
- (i) any funeral undertaking from any property or premises located on or adjacent to the roads or lengths of roads named;
- (j) Any vehicle being used to gain any reasonable access to any premises located on or adjacent to the roads or lengths of roads named for the purpose of the collection or delivery of goods;
- (k) Any vehicle being used by any resident of any premises located on or adjacent to the roads or lengths of roads named for the purpose of attending or leaving those premises;
- (l) Any vehicle being used by any person employed at any premises located on or adjacent to the roads or lengths of road named for the purpose of attending or leaving those premises.

Suspension or Modification

3. The Council's Director of Regeneration and Economic Development is hereby authorised, after consulting with the appropriate Chief Officer of Police, to modify or suspend, but not add to, the Order or any provisions within it.
