*In accordance with the decision of Cabinet in June 2018 a procurement exercise has been undertaken by the Director of Commissioning and Asset Management for the provisions of the following works which will cover various projects across the Killingworth Depot Site:

Killingworth Depot Refurbishment Works PRF 21-1000 EV Charging Points – DN649152.

To award the contract to the successful contractor to support the refurbishment and remodeling of the Killingworth site, an evaluation summary of the bids in relation are set out in Appendix 1 to this decision record.
