At its meeting on 27 September 2017 Cabinet agreed that the Deputy Chief Executive (now the Chief Executive), Head of Environment Housing and Leisure, Head of Commissioning and Investment (now the Head of Commissioning and Asset Management), Head of Finance (now the Head of Resources) and the Head of Law and Governance in consultation with the Deputy Mayor, the Cabinet Member for Finance and Resources and Cabinet Member for Housing and Transport conclude any arrangements required to implement the recommendation to bring the housing, repairs and maintenance service in-house.

As this matter relates to the procurement of sub-contractors to carry out responsive repairs this matter therefore falls within the remit of the Head of Environment, Housing and Leisure.

In accordance with the decision of Cabinet in September 2017 a procurement exercise has been undertaken by the Head of Environment, Housing and Leisure and this report seeks authority to award the contracts for the housing subcontractors.

Utilisation of existing frameworks was considered but discounted due to the scope of works not meeting the Authority's requirements and a limited number of providers.
