As the proposed sale price detailed in Section 1.5 of the report is below £0.250m, this matter can be considered in accordance with Item CAM67 of the Officer Delegation Scheme (June 2019).

By making the site available for development by a Registered Provider, this will assist in the Authority's priority of overseeing the delivery of 3000 affordable homes in the Borough by the end of 2024.
