To provide temporary accommodation assets by leasing empty private properties from landlords.

4. Executive summary

The Authority is experiencing unprecedented demand to provide temporary accommodation for homeless households. This demand cannot currently be met utilising the Authority's available housing stock alone and has resulted in an increase in the use of inappropriate and costly bed and breakfast accommodation. As a response to this increased pressure on current temporary accommodation provisions, it is proposed that the use of empty private sector housing assets is appropriate.
