5. Executive summary (taken from written report)

A Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) for variations to provision for on-street parking places on Norma Crescent and Cliff Row, Cullercoats ("the Traffic Regulation Order") was duly advertised and an objection was received.

The Traffic Regulation Order was originally proposed as part of a set of measures associated with the delivery of the Sea Front Sustainable Route project. However, it is considered that the objectives of the project can be achieved without the Traffic Regulation Order being made.

This Record of Decision relates to the approval given by the Cabinet Member for Environment for the Traffic Regulation Order not to be made.

6. Alternative Options considered

Option 1 – Approve the recommendations set out in section 1.2 of the report and determine that the Traffic Regulation Order should not be made.

<u>Option 2</u> – Not approve the recommendations set out in section 1.2 of the report and determine that the Traffic Regulation Order should be made unchanged.

Option 3 – Not approve the recommendations set out in section 1.2 and determine that the Traffic Regulation Order should be made with modifications.

7. Decision(s)

The Cabinet Member for Environment has considered the objection and has decided to:

- (1) note that the objectives of the Sea Front Sustainable Route project can be achieved without the Traffic Regulation Order being made; and
- (2)determine that the Traffic Regulation Order should not be made.

8. Reasons for the Decision(s)

Regarding the objection from **Ms C** – the Cabinet Member for Environment noted that the proposals no longer included the provision of permit parking on Promontory Terrace, to which the objection had related. The Cabinet Member for Environment further noted that the objectives of the Sea Front Sustainable Route project could be achieved without the Traffic Regulation Order being made.
