





Avant Homes

A1056 Killingworth Way Highway Improvement Scheme Improvements are planned for the A1056 Killingworth Way in support of a new housing development.

The work will be delivered by Capita and fulfils an agreement between Avant Homes and North Tyneside Council.





Introduction

In 2017, Avant Homes was granted planning permission for a housing development on land north of Killingworth Way.

A condition of the consent was that Avant Homes enters into an agreement with North Tyneside Council, under section 278 of the Highways Act, to deliver highways improvements.


These works include widening the A1056 Killingworth Way westbound, creating an access road for the development and constructing new pedestrian crossings.

Works are due to start in summer 2019 with completion expected in early 2020.

The works:

- Widening the A1056 Killingworth Way westbound to two lanes on the approach to A189/A1056 Weetslade roundabout.
- An access road serving the development from the A1056 Killingworth Way via a signalised T-junction.
- When Weetslade roundabout is signalised (planned for 2020 as part of Bellway's Moorfields development), the junction's signals will be activated and linked to the roundabout's, and the left and right junction exits will be available.
- A pedestrian crossing on the A1056 Killingworth Way and the access road.
- Bus stops on the A1056 Killingworth Way.

- 1. The new access road will include a signalised T-junction.
- The site access also incorporates widening of the A1056
 Killingworth Way to provide a two-lane westbound approach to
 the A189/A1056 Weetslade roundabout.
- 3. Two bus stops will be installed near the site access junction, improving the development's connectivity.
- 4. The bus stops will be served by new pedestrian crossings, which will be installed as part of the access road works.
