# Employer's Certificate

For the purpose of this statutory discount, a person is considered to be an apprentice if they:

- are employed for the purpose of learning a trade, business, profession, employment or vocation, and
- are undertaking a programme of training leading to a qualification accredited by the Qualifications and Curriculum Development Authority, and
- are employed at a salary or allowance which is not more than £195 per week, and
- the salary or allowance is substantially less than that they would expect to receive when qualified.

### **Declaration**

I also confirm that they are undertaking a programme of training leading to a qualification accredited by the Qualifications and Curriculum Development Authority.
