- (3) This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the North Tyneside Council Bridleway Wideopen 2, 4, 5 & 6 & Public Footpath 4A Definitive Map & Statement Modification Order 2019.

Commencing at its north end at its junction with Bridge Street, Wideopen - the path proceeds in a mainly southwest and then east direction to its end point at its junction with a definitive bridleway at the west end of Weetslade Country Park.

Existing Definitive Statement:

From the Newcastle - Morpeth Road opposite the Travelers' Rest Public House Wideopen, in an easterly direction by the south side of East Wideopen Farm crossing the Seaton Burn Wagonway to the Westmoor - Cramlington Road about 130 yards north of High Weetslade Farm.

New Definitive Statement:

Commencing at its west end at its junction with Park View, Wideopen - the path proceeds in a mainly east direction along the access road to East Wideopen Farm Cottages and Oak House. The path continues east through the north end of Five Mile Park housing estate where it crosses Stonecrop Drive and continues east, south west and east again through Weetslade Country Park. At the east end of the Country Park the path heads north east passing High Weetslade Farm Cottages to its end point at its junction with Great Lime Road, Dudley.

Width: - Varies between 2 metres and 4.3 metres

Comprising a total distance of approximately 548 metres

Commencing at its west end at its junction with Great North Road, Wideopen - the path proceeds in a mainly east direction where it crosses estate roads Dunnock Place and then Havannah Drive before heading north east to its end point at its junction with another definitive bridleway.

Width: - Varies between 2 metres and 2.5 metres

Wideopen 4A:

A Public Footpath situated south of Warkworth Drive, Wideopen, near the entrance to Greenfields Community Primary School, Wideopen marked (Point C to D) and connecting to a definitive bridleway on the access road north of Lockey Park, Wideopen on the attached map and described in the schedule to this order shall be added to the Definitive Map 43 days from the date of confirmation.

There shall be added to the Definitive Map a footpath from a point south of Warkworth Drive, Wideopen at:

to its end point at its junction with the access road and Definitive Bridleway north of Lockey Park, Wideopen at:

Grid Ref: NZ 24257 / NZ 72693 (Point D)

comprising a total distance of approximately 87 metres.

Definitive Statement:

Commencing at its north end at its junction with Warkworth Drive, Wideopen -the path continues south, north east and then south to its end point at its junction with a definitive bridleway on the access road north of Lockey Park - comprising of a total distance of approximately 87 metres.

Width – varies between 1 metre and 1.5 metres
