Infrastructure Delivery Schedule

This Infrastructure Delivery Schedule (IDS) has been prepared based upon the update to the North Tyneside Infrastructure Delivery Plan, Update 2017 and the Murton and Killingworth Site Specific IDP 2016.

The IDS provides a collated schedule of all potential infrastructure projects and an estimate of the potential costs for future infrastructure. There may be a range of potential sources of funding for infrastructure within the IDS including use of Section 106 agreements, Section 278 agreements and use of Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL). Sources of funding that are additional to potential developer contributions may also become available to support delivery of the infrastructure included in the IDS. This could take the form of grants and loans via the public sector and other private investment.

Projects included within the Infrastructure Delivery Schedule cover a wide range of issues. Not all projects will be required over the life of the Local Plan and at this stage the majority of projects are not committed or formally required.

Potential Project Delivery Leads

The following potential delivery leads have been identified in relation to potential infrastructure projects in North Tyneside.

- The Clinical Commissioners Group and NHS England in relation to primary health care
- North Tyneside Council in partnership with Natural England and Northumberland Wildlife Trust.
- Developers either on site or off site where permitted as part of agreement with the Authority.
- North Tyneside Council in delivery of its services including in relation to highways, education waste management and street cleaning, parks, play areas and sports provision
- Free school or Academy organisations under current national legislation where any new schools are required.
- Nexus, rail operators and transport operators in relation to public transport improvements and investment relating to metro or network rail track.
- Public private partnerships, particularly in relation to the delivery of regeneration schemes
- The Local Flood Authority in partnership with EA and where Northumbrian Water Ltd in relation to water management and flood risk projects.
