<p>This report seeks the approval of the Cabinet Member for Environment and Transport to introduce permit parking restrictions into Carlton Road, Tynedale Terrace, Eastfield Terrace, Maddox Road, Station Approach, West Avenue, Thornhill Road, The Grove, East Avenue, Queens Gardens, The Oval, Grange Avenue and Parkland in Benton and to set aside ten objections received to the proposal.</p>
