This report seeks the approval of the Cabinet Member for Environment to create a permanent School Street scheme outside Denbigh Community Primary School between the hours of 08:45-09:15 and 15:00-15:45 each day, involving a prohibition of entry for vehicular traffic into Denbigh Avenue between Monmouth Gardens and Grosvenor Gardens and into Radnor Gardens between Denbigh Avenue and Caroline Gardens, and to set aside one objection received to the proposal.
