5. Executive summary (taken from written report)

This report seeks the approval of the Cabinet Member for Environment to omit the southern zebra crossing included within the original scheme design following the further design reviews and site investigations.

6. Alternative Options considered

Option 1 - Approve the recommendations set out in section 1.2 and omit the southern zebra crossing from the scheme.

Option 2 - Not approve the recommendations set out in section 1.2 and determine the scheme is implemented as per original proposals.

7. Decision(s)

The Cabinet Member for Environment has considered the information provided in Section 1.5 of this report and;

- (1) Determined that the junction improvement scheme at Broadway/Mast Lane should be introduced with the exception of the southern zebra crossing and associated link footway.

8. Reasons for the Decision(s)

The removal of the proposed zebra crossing on the southern arm would:

- Address the remaining problems raised in the Stage 1 & 2 Road Safety Audit;
- Avoid shallow utility apparatus which would have the potential to require cost prohibitive diversions; and
- Address the concerns raised by the residents of [Address A] and [Address B] on Broadway.
