At its meeting of March 2022 Cabinet agreed that the Director of Housing and Property Services in consultation with the Director of Commissioning and Asset Management, the Director of Resources, the Director of Law and Governance and the Cabinet Member for Finance and Resources to establish a Dynamic Purchasing System (DPS) for Housing, Operational, schools and commercial buildings who will deliver a range of Works, Services including when required supplies to supplement the internal workforce.

The Authority have opted to establish a DPS as it is deemed the most appropriate option to meet its requirements and will enable a clear, consistent and compliant route to market. Thirty suppliers have passed the compliance checks to be set up on the DPS in Round One, and the DPS will be open to new entrants throughout its lifespan to allow coverage for ever changing requirements, including but not limited to new regulations and central government requirements
