On 26 October 2023 the Director of Regeneration and Economic Development authorised.

- (1) that notices for the proposal should be prepared and advertised in line with relevant statutory requirements;
- (2) that in the event that no objections are received following the period of consultation required by statute, that the circumstances do not warrant the holding of a Public Inquiry; and
- (3) that if no objections are received following the period of consultation required by statute, the Traffic Regulation Order shall be made.

The notices were prepared and advertised in accordance with the statutory requirements and three objections were received during the statutory advertising period in relation to the extent of the proposed waiting restrictions. In each case, the objector asked for consideration to be given to extending the proposed restrictions further north on Killingworth Road. Following further site observations and informal consultation with residents, it is now proposed that the scheme is amended to accommodate these representations as shown on the plan at Appendix 1 and readvertised in line with relevant statutory requirements.
