5. Executive summary (taken from written report)

This report seeks the approval of the Cabinet Member for Environment to install 'no stopping' restrictions (school keep clear markings) on the four corners of the Kielder Road / Kielder Place / Houxy Road junction on the Wellfield Estate and to set aside two objections received to the proposals.

7. Decision(s)

The Cabinet Member for Environment has considered the objections and has decided to:

Regarding the objection from Ms R and Mr P, the Cabinet Member for Environment noted that, the proposals to provide the no stopping restrictions (school keep clear markings) will address existing parking issues at the junction and should improve road safety for all road users in the vicinity of Wellfield Middle School.
