4. Executive summary

The purpose of the report is to seek approval for the award of contract for sub-contractors to carry out planned and responsive repairs to the operational, schools and commercial buildings.

At its meeting of 27 September 2017 Cabinet agreed that the Deputy Chief Executive (whose delegations are now discharged by the Chief Executive), Head of Environment, Housing and Leisure, Head of Commissioning and Asset Management, Head of Resources and the Head of Law and Governance, in consultation with the Deputy Mayor, the Cabinet Member for Finance and Resources and Cabinet Member for Housing, conclude any arrangements required to implement the recommendation to bring the housing, repairs and maintenance service in-house.

As this matter relates to the procurement of sub-contractors to carry out planned and responsive repairs to the operational, schools and commercial buildings stock this matter therefore falls within the remit of the Head of Commissioning and Asset Management.

5. Alternative Options considered

Utilisation of existing frameworks was considered but discounted due to the scope of works not meeting the Authority's requirements and a limited number of providers.

To approve the tender process and award of contracts to the highest scoring bidders as identified in the Evaluation Summary attached at Appendix 1 to the report as the bidders who provided the most economically advantageous tenders
