## 4. Executive summary

The purpose of the report is to seek approval for the award of five contracts for contractors to carry out part of the capital works to support the refurbishment and remodeling of the Killingworth site.

At its meeting of 25 June 2018 Cabinet agreed that the Head of Commissioning and Asset Management in consultation with the Head of Environment, Housing and Leisure, the Head of Finance (whose delegations are now discharged by the Head of Resources), the Head of Law and Governance and the Cabinet Member for Finance and Resources undertake a procurement exercise for the proposed funded works and to award contract(s) to those bidders successful in the procurement process who provide the Authority with the most economically advantageous tender(s) and in line with the agreed Investment Plan.

The report supersedes the delegated decision dated xxx where the decision was made to utilise the NEPO framework. A revised procurement strategy has been adopted to deliver the works.

In accordance with the decision of Cabinet in June 2018 a procurement exercise has been undertaken by the Head of Commissioning and Asset Management for the provisions of the following works:

- 1) Killingworth Block A External Envelope Windows and Doors DN420547
- 2) Killingworth Block A External Envelope External stair removal DN417171
- 3) Killingworth Block A External Envelope Sliding Folding Shutters DN417766

- 4) Killingworth Block A External Envelope Concrete Repairs DN41717; and
- 5) Killingworth Block A External Envelope Roofing Roofsafe Cladding D417141

This report seeks authority to award the contracts to the successful contractors to support the refurbishment and remodeling of the Killingworth site.
