# **4. Executive summary** (To be taken from written report)

On 4 November 2022 the Director of Regeneration and Economic Development authorised

- (1) that notices for the proposal should be prepared and advertised in line with relevant statutory requirements; and
- (2) that, in the event that no objections are received following the period of consultation, that the circumstances do not warrant the holding of a local inquiry; and
- (3) that if no objections are received following the period of consultation required by statute, the Traffic Regulation Order shall be made.

The notices were prepared and advertised in accordance with the statutory requirements and no objections were received in connection with this proposal. A representation was however received from a local resident in connection with an Experimental Traffic Regulation Order (ETRO), which has not been brought into operation at this time, which relates to part of Back Cheviot View.

The permanent TRO shall therefore be made with a modification such that it excludes a section of the south side of Back Cheviot View as shown in the updated scheme plan attached as Appendix 1.

#### 5. Alternative Options considered

### Option 1

To endorse recommendation (3) as set out in paragraph 1.2 of the 4 November 2022 Delegated Decision report – that the Traffic Regulation Order shall be made for the introduction of no waiting at any time restrictions in the vicinity of Cheviot View and A191 Front Street, Benton

- (1) To confirm that no objections were received during the statutory advertising period relating to the proposal;
- (2) That the circumstances do not warrant the holding of a local inquiry; and
- (3) That the Traffic Regulation Order shall be made with a modification such that the no waiting at any time restriction which shall be introduced shall exclude the following lengths of road:
  - a) Back Cheviot View, Benton:
    - i) on its south side, from its junction with Back Cheviot View Access Road to a point 8 metres west of that junction;
    - ii) on its south side, from a point 36 metres west of its junction with Back Cheviot View Access Road to a point 45 metres west of that junction; and
    - iii) on its south side, from its junction with Back Cheviot View Access Road to a point 4 metres east of that junction.
