& RAIL CROSSING DIVERSION ORDERS 2022  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119 & 119A  
DUDLEY 1 & 2**

On 30<sup>th</sup> January 2023 North Tyneside Council ('the Authority') confirmed the above-named orders, made under section 119 & 119A of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the orders as confirmed will divert the paths as described in the orders.

The orders come into force on 30<sup>th</sup> January 2023 but if a person aggrieved by the orders wants to question their validity, or that of any provision contained in them, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highway Act 1980, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, they may make an application to the High Court, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from today 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2023.
