Our provision is Universal – as a provider we have some SEND awareness and, with advanced notice, we are able to adapt and tailor some activities; our provision will not be suitable for children who require 1:1 support. SEND places will be limited for the safety and wellbeing of all children in attendance. A telephone conversation between ourselves and the parent/carer will take place before the SEND child attends. On any particular day, a maximum of 25 children will attend our provision. The staffing ratio of the provision is 7 children to 1 staff. The club venue is wheelchair accessible and is designed to accommodate children with physical disabilities. The club venue has an accessible toilet. We aim to adapt activities providing we have clear information relating to the ability of each child.

We are unable to provide 1-1 care although the parent/ carer is welcome to stay. We can provide accessible changing room / space for wheelchairs. We are not insured for EpiPen delivery. Personal Assistants (PAs) for children with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) are welcome to attend. Due to staffing, we can only accept a maximum of 4 SEND children per day. This is to ensure the safety and safeguarding of all children, their well-being to make sure they all receive equal attention.
