Welcome to a special edition of Your Holystone Update. Although the A19/A191 Holystone Improvement Scheme is complete, some remedial and snagging works are being addressed next week. This update explains what will be happening.

### At a glance

#### On the road:

Lane closures on Holystone Interchange on Monday, June 11 to Thursday, June 14 (9.30am to 3.30pm) and Friday, June 15 (8pm to midnight).

#### Walking and cycling:

Possible minor diversions at Holystone Interchange during week commencing Monday, June 11.

### Remedial works during w/c Monday, June 11

The A19/A191 Holystone Improvement Project was managed and delivered for North Tyneside Council by its partner Capita.

Next week, the sub-contractor that widened Holystone Interchange will be carrying out some remedial and snagging works:

**Signage** – Large signs indicating the lane to take will be installed on the A19 northbound and southbound offslips as well as the A186 (approaching from the Toby Carvery). The sign poles are already in place and this work will install the signs themselves.

**Pedestrian guardrail** – The connection points between the pedestrian guardrail and the footpath are untidy and will be improved.

**Crash barrier** – The reflective signs at the ends of the crash barriers will be re-secured and also reinstated where they are missing. In addition, gravel will be laid where the barriers connect to the concrete surface.

**Landscaping** – There will be rotovating, topsoiling and reseeding works on: the inner section of the roundabout; the location of the former satellite compound at Murrayfields; and the grassed verge on the eastern side of the roundabout between the A186 and A191 approaches. The sub-contractor will have responsibility for ongoing maintenance for 12 months after these works.

All works listed above will take place during week commencing Monday, June 11 and may require off-peak (9.30am to 3.30pm) minor pedestrian diversions only.

**Gullies** – All the gullies at Holystone Interchange will be cleared and visually inspected. There will be off-peak (9.30am to 3.30pm) lane closures on the Interchange from Monday, June 11 to Thursday, June 14 to enable gully work on the Interchange's inner ring. Lane closures on the outer ring will take place from 8pm to midnight on Friday, June 15 to minimise disruption to road users.
