What is the Inclusion Quality Mark (IQM)?

The IQM is an evaluative framework which supports organisational self-assessment. With a strong theoretical and research base, the IQM award provides a validation of current practice and a detailed report summarising the findings.

How do I apply for the IQM?

Schools can apply for a free information pack or they can register their interest in achieving the award (registration costs £49.50 plus VAT which is non-refundable) at www.inclusionmark.co.uk and they will receive full details of the process and the associated assessment costs (see below).

After registering the school you will be sent a Self-Evaluation Report (SER) document covering the 8 Elements of IQM. You should list the evidence you have against each criteria and where that evidence can be found should the assessor ask to see it during the assessment.
