A188/A189 West Moor roundabout scheme

Welcome to Your North West Highways Update for the A188/A189 West Moor roundabout scheme.

These works are being delivered by North Tyneside Council's partner Capita on behalf of Bellway Homes and will tie into the recently completed cycleway/footway on Salters' Lane.

At a glance

Walking and cycling: The safe crossing points will be open to pedestrians and cyclists this week when the signals are activated.

On the road: The road resurfacing work has now been completed and the roundabout traffic signals will be turned on this week.

Update

The construction team have now completed the roundabout resurfacing works at the A188/A189 West Moor roundabout. The roundabout traffic signals will be switched on this week - it is anticipated they will be activated on Wednesday July 6.

The roundabout pedestrian and cyclist safe crossing points will also be activated at the same time as the traffic signals. This will provide safe crossing points on the roundabout for pedestrians and cyclists. This will also provide access to the new shared cycleway/footpath on the A189 Salters' Lane.

When the traffic signals are switched on, they will be monitored on site during the activation process. Further programming of the traffic signals will take place over time so that they respond more intelligently to actual traffic flows around the clock.
