Supplementary Statement to North Tyneside Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment (PNA) 2018

This supplementary statement has been prepared and issued by the North Tyneside Health and Wellbeing Board, in accordance with the requirements set out under the National Health Service England (pharmaceutical Services and Local Pharmaceutical Services) Regulations 2013 (S1 2013 No. 349) and amended in 2014, 2015 and 2016 (“the Regulations”).

The statement has been issued in accordance with Part 2: 6 (3) of the Regulations and updates the PNA published by the North Tyneside Health and Wellbeing Board in March 2018.

The Regulations state that Supplementary Statements can provide updates to the PNA only in relation to changes in the availability of pharmaceutical services. Supplementary statements cannot provide updates on pharmaceutical need: this can only be achieved through a review of the PNA. The following pharmaceutical services continued within the PNA have been identified as needing updating. This updated information supersedes some of the original information within the current PNA and should be read in conjunction with the full document.

The Pharmaceutical Services Regulations Committee (PSRC) **approved** the **Consolidation Application** on the following basis:

Regulation 26A(1) is satisfied as Boots UK Limited is already included in the pharmaceutical list of North Tyneside HWB.

Regulation 26A(3) is satisfied as the application has been made by Boots UK Ltd, which owns both premises and no change of ownership is required.

Regulation 26A(5): Consolidating the pharmacies listed will not create a gap in pharmaceutical service provision for the following reasons:

- The two sites are located within a five-minute walk from each other.
 - This has been verified by CNE by use of Google Maps.
 - There are no barriers to access.
 - Site 1 Pharmacy offers greater opening hours.
 - Site 1 offers all services provided at site 2
 - Patients will continue to have choice of provider between Site 1, and a further 14 pharmacies within a 2 mile radius
- **Regulation 26A(5)(b)** does not apply as neither of the pharmacies is a distance-selling / internet pharmacy or a DAC.

Regulation 26A(6) is satisfied because:

- The same advanced/enhanced services will be provided from Site 1.
- There will be no interruption to services.
- No change of ownership is required.
- Site 2 will close following consolidation.

The PSRC also considered the following regulations:

Regulation 26A(2) does not apply as this is an excepted application.

Regulation 26A(4) is not applicable as Boots UK Ltd owns both sites.

Regulation 26A(7) does not apply as Boots owns both sites.

Regulation 26A(8) is not applicable as this is the only application for North Tyneside HWBB

Regulation 65 is not relevant as NHS England will not be directing the Pharmacy's opening hours.

Regulation 66 is not relevant as NHS England will not be directing the services to be provided.

Regulation 67 is not applicable as the closure of Site 2 is part of a consolidation application.
