Minor corrective works at Billy Mill junction: Wednesday 3 October

Some minor corrective works are due to be carried out at the Billy Mill junction next Wednesday, 3 October.

The construction team need to correct a small defect in the road surface on the slip road from Regent Terrace onto the westbound Coast Road; on the same evening they will also carry out some minor repairs to the eastbound Coast Road carriageway at the bus stop close to the My Shanghai restaurant.

The work near to My Shanghai will see the nearside lane of the eastbound Coast Road closed temporarily from around 11pm on the approach to Billy Mill. Drivers wishing to access Lynn Road will be able to make a safe left turn from the middle lane during the lane closure. The bus stop here will remain unaffected.

The Regent Terrace/Coast Road slip road will be closed from around 12 midnight on 3 October, after the last 308 and 306 buses. The nearside lane on Regent Terrace will be closed for a short distance, with vehicles able to use the offside lane to approach the traffic signals. Drivers will be able to turn left, turn right and go straight ahead to Lynn Road from this lane until the work is finished.

There will be a small amount of road planing needed on the slip road – but this is expected to last for a very short time and will be done as close to midnight as possible. Road planing is noisy so there will be some local disturbance whilst this is carried out.

Resurfacing work is quieter, but there will still be some noise from, for example, the alarms of reversing construction vehicles. The construction team will work in a considerate manner throughout.
